# NATIONAL SCHOOLS COUNTY ROUND

For schools competing to progress to the regional round of the National Schools Competition in U14, U16 and U19 age groups.

No player may take part in more than one age group in the National Schools Competition.

The winners and runners up in each age group progress to the South West Regional Round of the National Schools Competition on **Saturday 1**<sup>st</sup> **February 2025 in Bournemouth.** 

# COUNTY CHALLENGE COMPETITION

For schools whose aim is participation and competition with other schools of similar standard.

Also in this competition is the U15 (May Dent) tournament which sits outside the National Schools format, and is intended for this year group who would not normally get a competition.

- All schools must be members of England Netball prior to playing in the tournaments. Membership to be paid directly to England Netball <a href="https://engage.englandnetball.co.uk/">https://engage.englandnetball.co.uk/</a>
- Tournament entries will be £20.00 per team per tournament.
- All players must be under the specified age at midnight on 31st August 2024.
- All schools entering teams for the tournaments must provide a qualified umpire. Umpires
  from GCNA may be available to help. If you need help finding an umpire please contact

- If a team has to withdraw, they must:
  - a) inform the Tournament organiser as soon as possible. (within 48 hours)
  - b) still provide an umpire on the Tournament day.
- It is a condition of entry that members of staff/umpires make themselves available to umpire the final rounds if required to do so by the tournament referee.
- **N.B.** It is important that all schools are aware of their umpiring responsibilities in the semis and finals of these events. Teams who do not reach the finals of the Tournament are asked to remain until the end of the presentations.
- An independent tournament referee will be appointed to oversee each tournament.

GCNA run the County Under 13 Player Development Programme (previously Satellite Academy) and County Under 15 Player Development Programme (previously County Academy). These are for young players with the potential for development, as part of the England Netball Player Pathway Programme.
